1. Racing Rules of Sailing, Appendix S "Standard Sailing Instructions" will apply with amendments and supplements as set out in the Supplementary Sailing Instructions.

3. Scoring

3.1 Low point scoring system as per RRS Appendix A will be used.


3.2 When fewer than 5 races are completed, a boat's score will be the sum of its points.

3.3 When 5 or more races are completed, a boat's total score will be the sum of its points minus the worst score from one race.

- 8.3 Accurate description of the marks will be given at the Competitor Briefing on Saturday 15th of September at the Regatta Office at 10.00.
- 6. RRS Part 2, Rule 44.1 is changed so that a One Turn Penalty replaces the Two Turn Penalty.
- 7. RRS Appendix S, Rule 4;
 - 3.1 Signals on land will be displayed on the pier at "Nørvevika båthavn"
 - 3.2 When flag AP is shown on land will "1 minute" be replaced with "No less than 45 minutes" in the race signal AP.
- 8. RRS Appendix S, Rule 12.1;

Mark 1 Time Limit	30 minutes
Race Time Limit	75 minutes
Finishing Window	15 minutes

9. Safety

9.1 A boat that retires from a race will inform the Regatta Committee as soon as possible.

10. Price giving

10.1 There will be prizes for the top 1/3 boats, up to a maximum of 3 prize-wining boats.

10.2 The prize-giving ceremony will be held as soon as practicable after completion of the final race on Sunday the 16th of September.

11. Liability disclaimer & Insurance

11.1 Sailors will participate solely on their own responsibility, see also RRS rule 4, "Decision to Race". The organisers take no responsibility for damage to equipment, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after, the regatta.

11.2 Each boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 950 000 EURO per incident or the equivalent in other currency.
